

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION – MAY 2018

Lucy Taylor advised the PC that she would like to start up a Tytherington in Bloom society. She had written a piece in Five Alive advising that a meeting will be held in The Swan on Monday 9th July. Once set up she would like to apply for a grant from the PC for containers to be located along Stowell Road and Duck Street. The clerk had sourced the forms so that they could apply for licences to site the containers and also a sample constitution from Thornbury in Bloom. The PC advised that they could authorise a grant in principle which could be released once the Association was up and running.

A representative from North & Letherby spoke on the subject of **Application No:** PT17/5808/F The Copse West Street Tytherington Wotton Under Edge South Gloucestershire **Description:** Demolition of existing detached garages and erection of 1 no. dwelling and associated works (resubmission). After debate the PC decided they could find no objection to the planning application.

A resident asked the PC if they could identify and explain their reason for selling a strip of land alongside Woodside Bungalow. The Chair explained that the residents of Woodside Bungalow had asked if they could purchase the land as they had maintained it for over 15 years and wanted to make the boundary of their property more secure. The land in question amounts to 100sm and they had made an offer to purchase even though it was possible that they would succeed in a claim for adverse possession as they had had uncontested use for a long period of time. The resident advised that the land in question was registered in the name of Tytherington Parish Council. The resident also thought that this land was part of the SNCI. The PC agreed to pause the sale and check whether the land in question was part of the SNCI.
